Because...

- ULD have always been treated as “ off the radar”, only coming to the front when bad stuff happens
- ULD considered “simple enough to understand without any expertise”
- Typical ULD cost adds up little by little- rarely a single big hit

Definition

- A common code of conduct is written for employees of a company, which protects the business and informs the employees of the company's expectations. It is ideal for even the smallest of companies to form a document containing important information on expectations for employees. The document does not need to be complex or have elaborate policies, but the file needs a simple basis of what the company expects from each employee.



Deliverables

- That a basic level of conduct be widely promoted wherever ULD are to be found, with the ambition that the PEOPLE who handle the ULD observe the ULD CARE ULD Code of Conduct.
- That an understanding of the very most basic principles of ULD be widely understood





How does it work?

- ULD CARE publishes the ULD Code of Conduct
 - Partly “hard copy”
 - Mainly on line material- easily accessed
- ULD CARE supports the C of C through ULD Explained, ULD Instruct and ULD Connect
- Voluntary on line sign up with ULD CARE managed database of registered companies.

ULD CARE Code of Conduct for ULD Operations and Handling

Given that it is essential for safe and efficient airline and air cargo operations that all ULD handling and operations are performed to an acceptable manner:

By signing to the ULD CARE ULD CODE of CONDUCT:

Airlines, other owners, vendors, service providers and manufacturers of ULD undertake to provide the industry with ULD that are fit for purpose, and to provide as necessary clear instruction and guidance as to their safe and efficient operation.

Organizations whose business involves the handling and operation of ULD undertake to implement these 10 practices:

1. Handle and operate ULD in a responsible manner.
2. Operators shall only perform tasks for which they are currently qualified.
3. Respect that ULD are aircraft equipment providing flight safety cargo restraint in flight.
4. Store ULD in a damage free manner and appropriate environment.
5. Move and transport ULD using damage free methods.
6. Only use ULD that have been serviceability checked before use.
7. Build stable loads observing all aircraft and ULD limitations.
8. Report transfers and stocks of ULD as required by the owner airlines.
9. Treat ULD accessories with proper care and attention.
10. Study OEM instructions and/or take specialist training course before working with cargo requiring special handling.

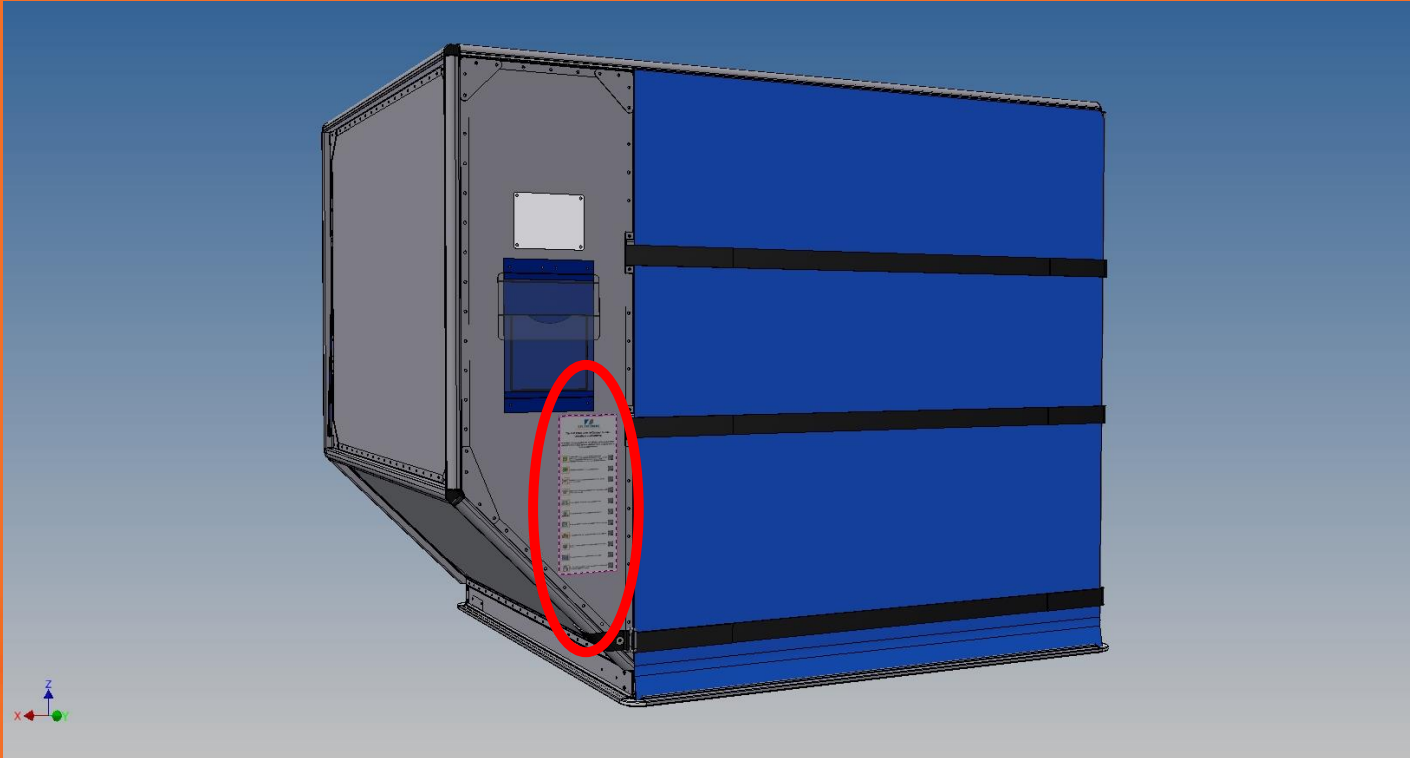
